

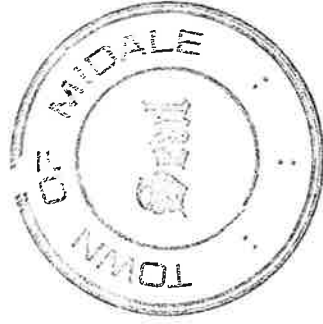
Bylaw # 2021-01
A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MIDALE, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN,
REGARDING SNOW REMOVAL WITHIN IN THE TOWN LIMITS


The council of the Town of Midale in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. **The Town of Midale** shall remove snow from Town streets anytime following a snow fall. This will be done in a timely manner.
2. Access to the **Midale/ Cymri Fire Hall, Mainprize Manor & Health Center and the Midale Central School** shall be the priority, all residential and business districts shall be as time permits, at the operator's discretion.
3. **The Town of Midale** may remove snow from back alleys as a secondary priority at the operator's discretion and or as time permits.
4. Ratepayers are not allowed to move snow from private property onto the drive portion of any roadway or alley. All snow removal from private driveways, sidewalks or private property must be placed on the owners or occupant's own property.
5. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offense and shall be liable to a fine ranging from a minimum \$200.00 to a Maximum \$1,000.00.

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.
