

BYLAW NO. 2022-02

CURBSIDE WASTE AND RECYCLING RATES BYLAW

**A Bylaw of the Town of Midale, in the Province of Saskatchewan, to
Fix the Rates to Be Charged for the Curbside Waste and Recycling Bins
and the Care and Responsibility of these Bins.**

The Council of the Town of Midale, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

1.1 This Bylaw may be cited as the *Waste and Recycling Rates Bylaw*.

2. PURPOSE

2.1 The purpose of this Bylaw is set rates and charges to be paid for the use of the waste and recycling bins, and for the care and responsibility of these bins.

3. PROVISIONS

3.1 All curbside bins must be placed on the street by 8:00 a.m. the morning of the collection to ensure they will be picked up and emptied by the waste management company.

3.2 All curbside bins should be removed from the street as soon as possible after they have been emptied and returned to the owner's premises or property.

3.3 Curbside bins left on the street twenty-four (24) hours after the time of emptying are considered as being non-compliant and in default of this bylaw; and the owners will be subject to a fine of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars. Failure to pay this fine will result in the fine being added to the utility bill of this property.

3.3 The rates to be charged for the waste and recycling collection shall be set forth in Schedule "A" attached and billed out with the quarterly Town of Midale utility bills.

4. REPEAL BYLAWS

4.1 Bylaw No. ~~2018-08~~ ²⁰¹³⁻⁰⁸ be hereby repealed upon the date of this bylaw coming into force.

5. COMING INTO FORCE

5.1 The Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final approval of the Saskatchewan Municipal Board.

“SCHEDULE A”

TO BYLAW 2022-02

WASTE AND RECYCLING RATES

1. All residential dwellings (excluding Midale Housing Authority) shall be provided with a set of bins which includes one (1) curbside waste bin and one (1) curbside recycle bin; and shall be billed quarterly and charged:

Charge per month per set
\$22.00

Charge per billing cycle per set
\$66.00

2. Midale Housing Authority shall be charged a rate of twenty-two (\$22.00) dollars per set of bins utilized per month, billed quarterly in the amount of sixty-six (\$66.00) dollars per set per billing cycle.
3. If an additional set of bins are requested for a residential dwelling, they shall be charged out at double the current billing rates.
